

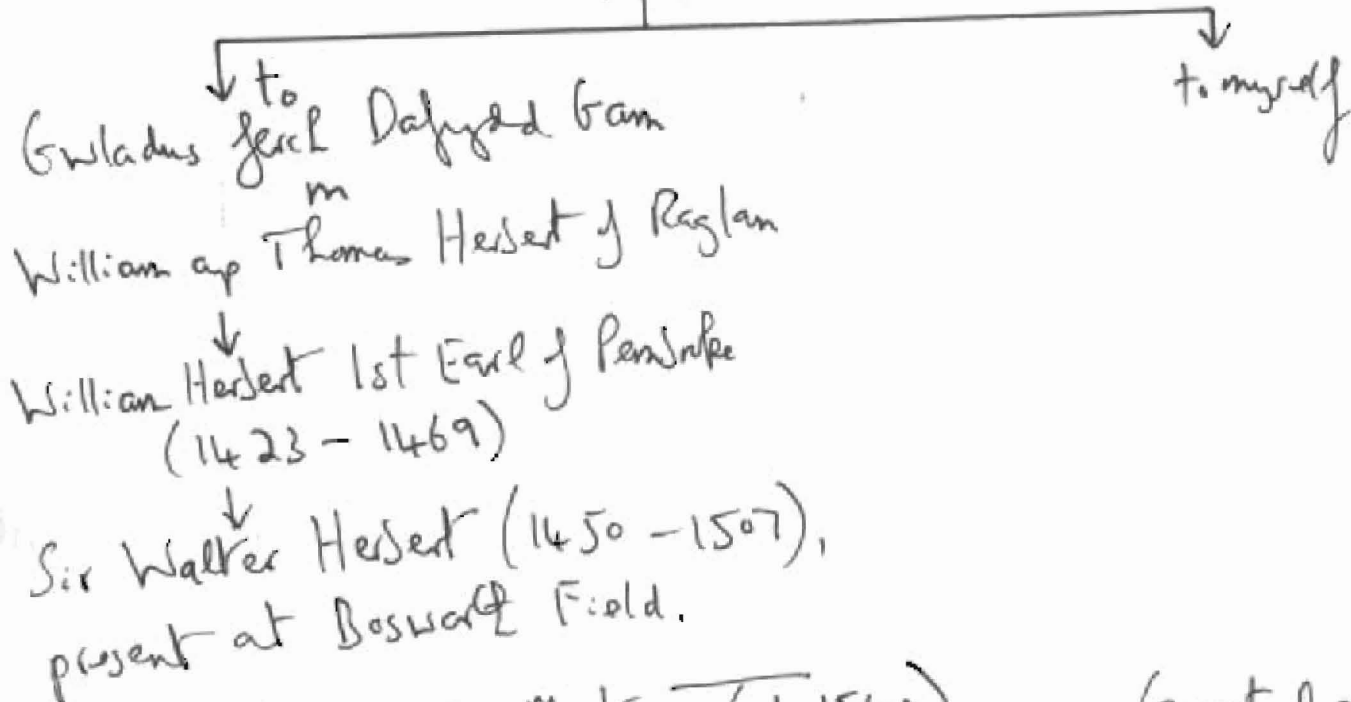
To date I have identified eleven ancestral cousins who were present at Bosworth, one of the key events in British history. They were all related to Henry VII Tudor. These are the lines of Sir Walter Herbert of Raglan (1450 - 1507), and Richard ap Hywel of Mostyn (died 1540), ancestor of the distinguished Mostyn Family. Acknowledgments to the Turner-Thomas site. Sir Walter Herbert's grandmother was Glwadus ferch Dafydd Gam, descended from Bleddyn ap Maenarch. Richard ap Hywel was descended from Ieuan ab Adda, who married Angharad ferch Ednyfed of the present Queen's Tudor line, which can be traced back to Gwenllïan ferch Rhys ap Gruffudd and Rhys ap Tewdwr. The daughter of Prince Rhys ap Tewdwr, the Princess Elinor ferch Rhys, married Prince Bleddyn ap Maenarch. Ieuan ab Adda was descended as shown from Tudur Trefor ab Ynyr, who married Angharad ferch Hywel Dda, my ancestral cousin (King Hywel the Good of the Royal House of Dinefawr (Dynevor)).

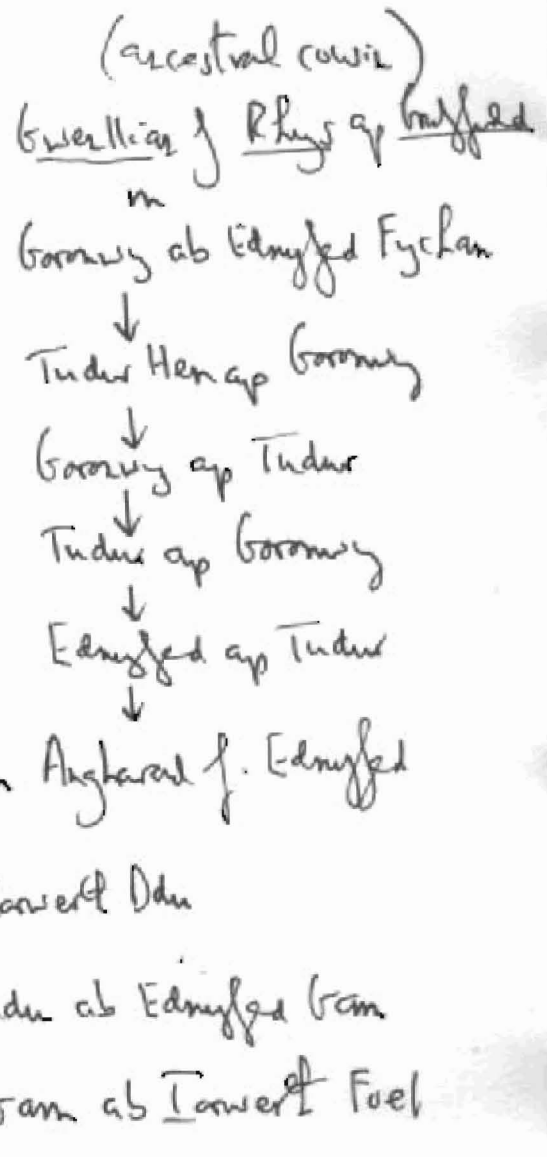
